A simple dress/tunic for obitsu 11cm



Materials:

- 2mm needles,
- Thread (I usually use these: Nitárna Česká Třebová s.r.o. Snehurka, Ariadna Kaja, Altin Basak Stokrotka) or 1ply yarn,
- Small snap (I use 5mm).

Abbreviations:

K - knit

P - purl

CO - cast on (I usually use „Cable Cast on“ method to make sleeves)

kfb - knit 1 stitch in the front, then in the back

k2tog - knit 2 stitches together

k2tog tbl - knit 2 stitches together, through the back loops

Directions:

CO 42 sts (leave a slightly longer thread, you will need it to sew up a dress)

1-2 row: K1, *K1, P1* (repeat from * to *), K1

3 row: Knit

4 row: Purl

Repeat rows 3-4 eight times (or more if you want a longer dress)

19 row: K5 *K2tog, K3*(repeat 6x *to*), K2tog, K5 (35)

20 row: Purl

21 row: K5 *K2tog, K2*(repeat 6x *to*), K2tog, K4 (28)

22 row: P28, CO 3 sts



23 row: K10, CO 9sts, K14, CO 9 sts, K7 (49)



24 row: P46, K3

25 row: K8, K2tog tbl, K2tog, K2, kfb, K2, K2tog tbl, K2tog, K10, K2tog tbl, K2tog, K2, kfb, K2, K2tog tbl, K2tog, K5 (43)

26 row: P40, K3

27 row: K7, K2tog tbl, K2tog, K4, K2tog tbl, K2tog, K8, K2tog tbl, K2tog, K4, K2tog tbl, K2tog, K4 (35)

28 row: P32, K3

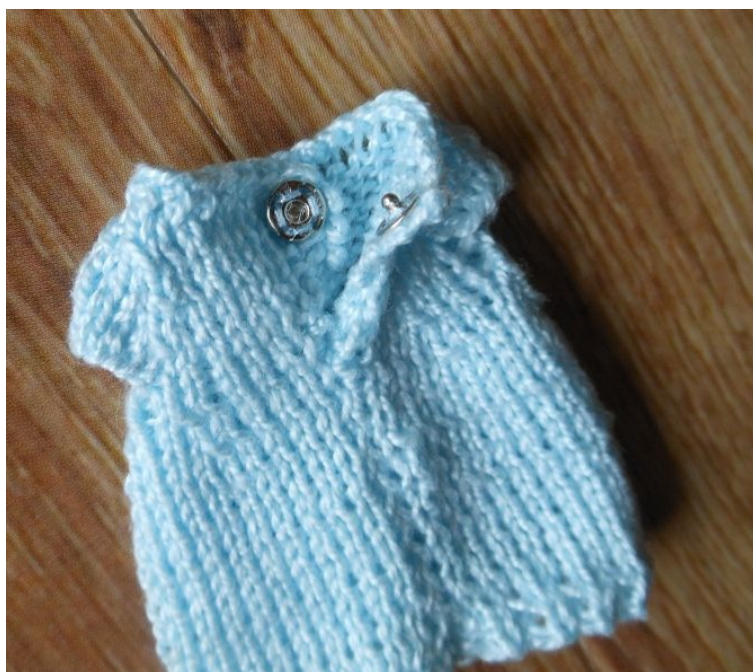
29 row: K7, K2tog, K2tog, K2tog, K2tog, K8, K2tog, K2tog, K2tog, K2tog, K4 (27)

30 row: P24, K3

Bind off all sts.

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Sew up on the back, weave in loose ends, sew on a snap.



You can use colored buttons or ribbons to make the dress more unique.
